



ANZMAC Executive Committee Member (2027-2029 inclusive)

NOMINATION FORM

Eligibility

1. Nominees must be **current Individual Members** of ANZMAC in 2026 (i.e., membership via ANZMAC 2025 Conference participation or a separate paid individual membership for 2026);
2. Only **ONE** Executive Committee member **per institution** is permitted at any one time;
3. For institutions with no continuing Executive Committee member, **multiple nominees** may run in the election, but only **the one with the most votes** will be successful in joining the Committee;
4. Nominees must attend (in-person or online) ANZMAC's AGM for 2026 on **Monday, 30 November** (to hear the election outcomes and, if successful, to accept the position).

Nomination Process

1. **Complete page 2 of this nomination form** with all details required and a 100-word nominee statement.
2. The nomination form must be **signed by a nominator** who is a current Individual Member of ANZMAC **on page 3**. If the nominator is not the nominee's Head of School (HoS) / Head of Department (HoD), the nominee needs to ensure **HoS / HoD support** (signature required on page 2) prior to submitting this nomination, as funding may be needed to attend in-person Executive Committee meetings.
3. **Email the completed form** to Rico Piehler at rico.piehler@mq.edu.au by **5:00 pm (AEDT) / 7:00 pm (NZDT), Thursday, 15 October 2026**. An email confirmation will be sent that the nomination has been received.

Election Process

Election to the ANZMAC Executive Committee is governed by the ANZMAC Constitution (<https://anzmac.org/constitution/>). For the 2026 election, there are **TWO (2) positions available**, for a term of three years (2027-2029).

If the number of nominations exceeds the number of available positions, a ballot must be held. If a ballot is required, a voting link will be emailed to all current individual ANZMAC members (as of 15 October 2026) in November 2026, with **voting concluding at 5:00 pm (AEDT) / 7:00 pm (NZDT) on Sunday, 29 November 2026**.

The ANZMAC Constitution also includes the necessary provisions for regional representation, with a minimum of three members from Australia and a minimum of three members from New Zealand overall for the full Executive Committee. Hence, these provisions need to be accounted for against the number of vacancies available, the nominations received, and the final list of successful nominees. As there are currently three continuing members from each country, **there are no regional requirements in this election**. There is also a requirement for at least two elected Indigenous Representative positions on the Executive Committee (1. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples and 2. Māori), which involve a separate appointment process. Nominees successfully elected to the ANZMAC Executive Committee will be announced by the President of ANZMAC (or delegate) at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) for 2026, on Monday, 30 November, which will be held at the end of the first day of the ANZMAC 2026 conference and online.
